Who with his love will befriend us.



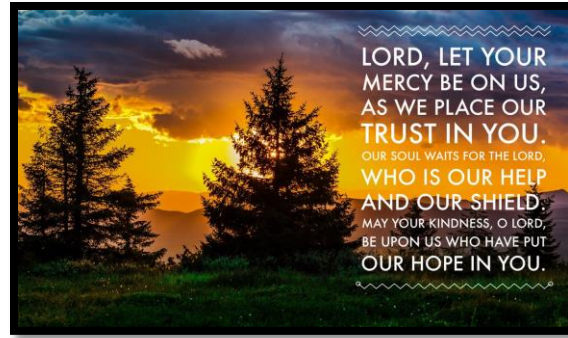
Gloria
